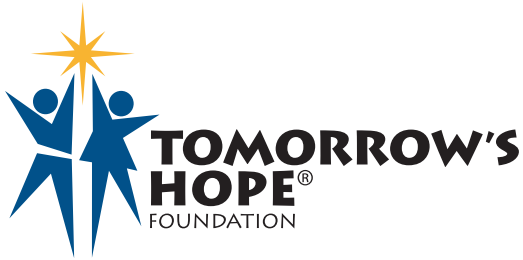

A Message from our Chairman and Executive Director

For 18 years, Tomorrow's Hope has strived to advance its mission to make Catholic elementary school attainable for children of underserved families on Long Island and provide programmatic funding to enhance learning experiences that guide all students in their religious, spiritual, moral, and academic development.

Thanks to the generosity of our donors this year, Tomorrow's Hope disbursed a record \$2.5 million in need-based scholarship aid to nearly 1,100 students. To put that in perspective, this compares to \$1.72 million that was awarded to 972 students in the 2007-08 school year. Sixteen years later, the Foundation's efforts to give children the opportunity to receive a faith-based education have not waned or wavered. Your steadfast support enables us to continue doing this important work.

What has changed is how Tomorrow's Hope raises its funds, a shift that was prompted by the pandemic. Events helped Tomorrow's Hope generate millions of dollars in scholarship support over the years, but the model was challenged when COVID upended the Foundation's annual Gala and Christmas plans. Thankfully, we could celebrate in-person once again this year, and our events were successful and well-attended. But for Tomorrow's Hope, the year has been transformative. Today, our work extends beyond events. The Foundation fully established an Annual Fund, as well as a planned giving program—The Legacy of Hope Society—aimed at encouraging donors to consider the Foundation in their estate plans.

Efforts to secure additional foundation revenue yielded a \$100,000 tech grant from the Francis & Gertrude Levitt Foundation. Tomorrow's Hope was also blessed for another year with a \$750,000 scholarship grant from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation, which made a significant impact on our ability to meet the greater need.

This year, we had a 25% increase in the number of students receiving the maximum award of \$3,500. The compounded worries of inflation, a higher cost of living, and an 11% tuition increase have many of our families still trying to stay afloat. And yet they strongly believe that a Catholic education is their only chance in changing the trajectory of their children's lives, pulling them out of hardship and raising them into adults of strong character, faith, and integrity.

Together, we make this a reality for our students, and your continued support changes their lives. We remain tirelessly committed to the beautiful children we serve and our vital mission,
Today's Children are Tomorrow's Hope!

History and Mission

of Tomorrow's Hope Foundation

The mission of Tomorrow's Hope Foundation is to ensure the excellence as well as the continuance of Catholic schools on Long Island by increasing awareness and by providing scholarship and program funding for the needs of students and schools.

Together with the DRVC Department of Education, the seventeen-year history of the Foundation is one of collaborative dedication to educational excellence and opportunity. Every year, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation provides partial tuition assistance to the 35 Catholic elementary schools across Long Island for families in need who wish to give the gift of a Catholic education to their children. In return, “our” children receive an academically rigorous education in a nurturing and safe environment.

Since 2005, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation has provided over \$27 million in tuition assistance to nearly 22,000 elementary school students from many diverse communities in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. This year alone, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation awarded \$2.5 million in tuition assistance to nearly 1,100 elementary students with the continued support from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation.



In December 2019, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation underwent a restructuring. Earlier that year, the Board of Directors determined that the most effective way to further the original Foundation's charitable purposes, which had changed since its inception, was to operate on its own as opposed to being a supporting organization of the Diocese of Rockville Centre. This new legal entity is known as “Tomorrow's Hope Foundation II, Inc.” (THF II). THF II exists independently from the Diocese, and the majority of its members are independent of the Diocese as well. In addition, the charitable purposes of THF II have expanded to include a broader range of activities, but still continues the activities of the original Foundation. It is important to note that THF II is still doing business as Tomorrow's Hope Foundation.

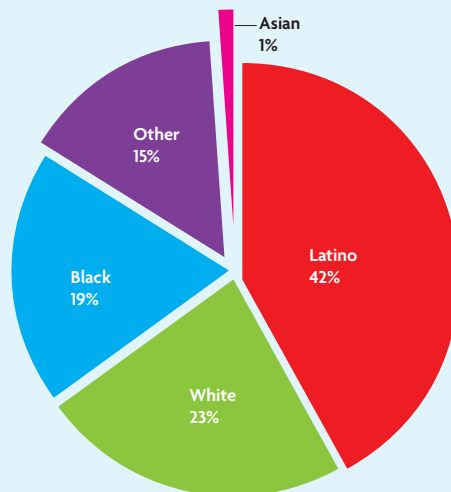

STAR Program

Be a STAR to a Student!

The Student Tuition Assistance Relationship (STAR) Program identifies students in high need of tuition assistance and matches them with a generous donor—a “STAR” who contributes \$2,500 annually to assist in that student’s tuition. The current average tuition for Catholic elementary school is approximately \$6,100, so this program is intended to fund roughly half of the student’s tuition while the parent/guardian is asked to contribute the remainder. The donor-student relationship consists of correspondence facilitated by Tomorrow’s Hope throughout the school year, including artwork, letters, and holiday cards. On average, Tomorrow’s Hope has more than 100 students in our STAR Program annually.



Your Impact: A STAR sponsor gets to see firsthand how their generous contribution directly aids in allowing their STAR student to thrive in a Catholic elementary school.

Donors who contribute to the STAR Program also have the opportunity to make a long-term pledge for their student(s), promising to support their elementary education(s) over a period of up to nine years. With the help of Tomorrow’s Hope and Theresa’s love for her granddaughter, Ava is now a 4th-grade student attending St. Mary School in East Islip. She is surrounded by supportive teachers and classmates. Ava is thriving and has joined the choir, sings hymns in the car, and enjoys going to Mass. “I am very grateful that she has the opportunity to attend Catholic school,” says Theresa.

Janine and Michelle’s sister, Donna, passed away unexpectedly in October 2020 leaving their twin nephews, Dominic and Donovan, without a mother. Janine and Michelle were awarded custody of their nephews who have been attending Catholic elementary school since kindergarten. Before her death, Donna made Michelle promise two things: to bury her in a cemetery near their house and to keep her sons in Catholic school as long as possible.

Sadly, June was diagnosed with a brain tumor just after her First Communion and has struggled with testing, evaluations, and rehab for the past five years. Her learning was affected in those early days as was her socialization.

The combination of her faith-filled family, a supportive parish and school community, and the aid from Tomorrow’s Hope has helped June to develop into a well-spoken honor roll student, who is now running on the cross-country team and competes with the school Tap Dance team!

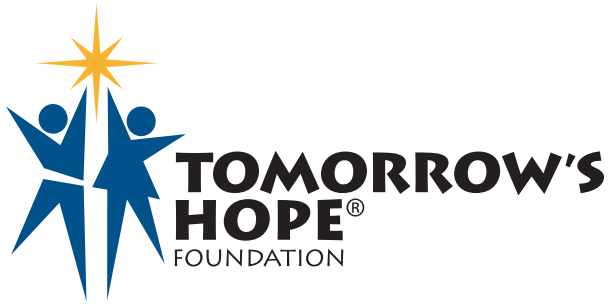
