A Message From Our Chairman

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, the staff and I join together in gratitude for your tremendous support throughout the year. It is your generosity during the 2015-2016 academic year that has allowed Tomorrow's Hope to once again award nearly \$2 million in tuition assistance to nearly 2,000 students within the Diocese of Rockville Centre, over 500 of whom are new scholarship families. The schools highlighted in each show receive funding from Tomorrow's Hope Foundation as well as families who have benefited from your generosity. The common theme throughout is the steadfast commitment to our mission, "Today's Children are Tomorrow's Hope!"

he mission of Tomorrow's Hope Foundation is to ensure the excellence as well as the continuance of Catholic elementary schools on Long Island by increasing awareness and by providing scholarship and program funding for the needs of students and schools.

In January 2004, Bishop William F. Murphy and former Superintendent of Schools and current Secretary of Education, Sister Joanne Callahan, became increasingly concerned about the costs and sustainability of Catholic elementary schools on Long Island. They enlisted a committee to study the challenges facing the schools. In answering the call to action to reverse the declining numbers of students in the Catholic elementary schools across Long Island, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation was established in September 2005 as a tax-exempt, non-for-profit public charity. Lewis S. Ranieri was appointed by Bishop Murphy to chair the foundation. As chairman, Mr. Ranieri put together a prominent board of professionals, business leaders and diocesan administration. Over eleven years later, there are 47 thriving elementary schools in our diocese educating more than 17,000 students. Parents seeking tuition assistance for their children now have a place to rely on for support. In it's history the Foundation has provided over \$20 million in scholarship and school aid, and helped thousands of families across Long Island. On behalf of Tomorrow's Hope, we look forward to continuing our service to the community through the generosity of our supporters.

A Message From the Superintendent

This year will find new and exciting programs in many of our schools and a focus on learning in both the academic core subjects as well as in our faith.

One of our major goals is to continue to support the faith life begun at home and foster a deep desire to learn and grow in the teachings of the church. STAR Program

Be a STAR to a Student, Be a Guiding Light!

he Student Tuition Assistance Relationship (STAR) Program identifies students in high need of tuition assistance and matches them with a generous donor—a "STAR" who contributes tuition assistance of \$2,000 a year. The current average tuition for Catholic elementary school is roughly \$4,500. Although tuition varies across the Diocese, this program is intended to fund roughly half of the student's tuition while the parent/guardian is asked to contribute the remainder.

The donor-student relationship is a special one—it consists of correspondence facilitated by Tomorrow's Hope throughout the school year. This relationship is unique in that the donor can see how their generous contribution directly aids in allowing their STAR student to thrive in Catholic elementary school.



A narrative from the Werner Family in their experience with Catholic Education and Tomorrow's Hope Foundation.

As parents, we always wanted to do the best we could for our children. Part of our desire to help them on their faith journey was to send them to Catholic school where our values and faith would be encouraged and nurtured as it was in our home. ast year, in honor of its tenth year of supporting Catholic elementary schools across Long Island, Tomorrow's Hope Foundation teamed up with Telecare, the Uniondale-based, national Catholic television network, to create the "Tomorrow's Hope" series. Hosted by Long Island's own Bernadette Castro, the series was so successful that another complete season was taped and it will begin airing in conjunction with 2017 Catholic Schools Week.

Each program is presented in a lively, half-hour interview format, with other segments filmed remotely, highlighting various schools that are supported by Tomorrow's Hope Foundation. The topics chosen for each season all cover various positive aspects of receiving a Catholic education on Long Island and how the Foundation has played a central role in enabling more than 1,700 children annually be among those privileged students.
